### Collection History:

Scott E. Flack, son of Linda and Don Flack, was born on 18 August 1960 and died of AIDS on 25 August 1987. He received a BA from Michigan State University in 1982 and a JD from Rutgers Law School. After graduation, he worked various legal positions in Camden, NJ, Philadelphia, PA, and Washington, DC until his untimely death in 1987.

### Custodial History:

The collection was donated to Gerber/Hart by Linda and Don Flack, parents of Scott, on 14 August 1992. The collection was received in “good” conditions.

### Scope and Content:

The collection consists mainly of documents, with one additional photograph, seemingly of Scott E. Flack and family.

### Arrangement:

Arrangement of the collection remains in original order, with an additional folder for “miscellaneous” documents.
