The '87 March on Washington took place on October 11, 1987. It followed the first March on Washington for Lesbian, Gay and Bi Equal Rights, which happened in 1979. The March of '87 focused on the AIDS crisis, as well as sodomy laws, discrimination, racism, sexism, and other civil rights issues affecting members of the LGBT community.
